FEASTS: Wed. 4th March St Casimir, Sat. 7th March Sts Perpetua and Felicity

FEAST OF THE WEEK: St Casimir lived from 1458 to 1484 and was a prince of Poland, born in Krakow. Involved in war in his early years he refused to take up arms against any Christian country. He refused to marry and adopted life of celibacy, devotion and austerity. He was conspicuous in his veneration of the Holy Eucharist and The Blessed Virgin Mary. He died of TB at the age of 26. Miracles were soon reported at his tomb leading to his canonisation by Leo X in 1521. In the 16th and 17th centuries the Lithuanians sought his supernatural help in conflicts with Russia and he became patron saint of that country.
