Deanery Synodal Council – A volunteer needed from each parish

As part of our response to the Synod last year each deanery in the Archdiocese is establishing a Synodal Council. It will meet three or four times a year with a lay representative from each parish in our deanery. The Council will look at how our parishes can work more closely together, share our resources, and will support us in implementing the changes agreed upon at our Synod. Our representatives will be regular worshippers in their parish and be available to attend meetings across the deanery. The first meeting will take place at St Gregory's on Monday 3rd October. 
Fun Quiz and raffle.
