**The distribution of the Precious Blood has now been restored, for those who wish to receive from the chalice.**

We have been asked to remind our parishioners that it is **not permitted** in the Catholic Church in England and Wales to receive the Precious Blood by “intinction”, that is by dipping the Host into the chalice. We ask you to respect this rule in our churches.

We have lost a few of our Special Ministers of Holy Communion over the past few years and need more volunteers to come forward to help so we may not be able to distribute the Precious from the chalice at every Mass yet.



*If you attend Mass each week in our parishes and would like to volunteer as a Special Minister of Holy Communion please talk to Fr Mark. This role requires a DBS check and volunteers are asked to attend a meeting for training before they are commissioned to exercise their ministry at celebrations of the Eucharist. We will offer a training afternoon for new Ministers and for our current Ministers who want a “refresher” when we know how many new volunteers we have. Please give becoming part of this important ministry some consideration and talk to Fr Mark after Mass or on 01257 460154 if you would like to volunteer or have any questions. Thank you.*
