We ask this through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.*

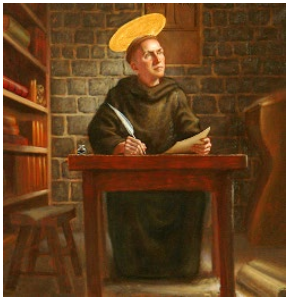
