**Soup & Sandwiches Summer Lunch** is on 16<sup>th</sup> July at 12noon in **St. Chad's Parish Centre**. Everyone is very welcome to come along. It's a free event but donations towards the cost are welcome. Good food and good company. Please join us if you can.



Tuesday, 30<sup>th</sup> July 10am – 4pm Retreat Day. As part of the celebrations for the Bicentenary of St Bede's Parish we have booked a retreat day at Hyning Hall Monastery, Warton near Carnforth. There will be a talk from one of the sisters, Mass and Holy Hour and we will join the community for Midday prayer in the chapel. There will be plenty of time to spend in the extensive gardens. The sisters have space for 30 day guests. To keep costs down we are asking people to bring a packed lunch and to make their own way there. We are hoping that people might offer a lift to anyone who can't get there by car. It's a 35 mile, 40 minute drive – 7 minutes off the M6 Carnforth exit. There are envelopes at the back of church to book your place. We ask for £10 from each

participant if you can manage that. Speak to Fr Mark if you can't. If the event is oversubscribed, we will arrange for a second day of retreat so everyone can get a chance to take part. We have 14 people signed up so far. Quite a few lifts are available. The Liverpool Archdiocesan Youth Pilgrimage to Lourdes departs on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July and Coach 5 covers our local area. This year we have 41 young people on Coach 5, aged between 15 and 22, who will



be serving our Assisted Pilgrims. Each of the seven youth coaches will carry a lantern in procession throughout the week which will contain Prayer Intention cards. At the end of the pilgrimage, these cards will be left at the Grotto. Please use any of the cards that have been left at the back of church or your own piece of paper. There is a Loop System in both our churches for people who use a hearing aid. We rely on people who use it to let us know when it isn't working. Thank you.
