This week we mark the beginning of Lent on Ash Wednesday. Masses are 9.15am at St Chad's and 11am and 7pm at St Bede's

prepare for the celebration of Holy Week and Easter.

The website for registration for the Sacrament of Confirmation is now open and will close on the 17th March. Any young person **in year 8** can register for Confirmation preparation at

<u>www.liverpoolcalled.co.uk</u>. Young people in Catholic schools will be given preparation through school. Additional preparation will be offered to young people attending a non-Catholic school. Once we have a date for the celebration of Confirmation, we will be in touch with the candidates who have registered from our parishes to invite them to a preparation evening.

If there are any adults who for whatever reason have not been confirmed please talk to Fr Mark. We can arrange for you to receive this sacrament in the parish if you wish.
