

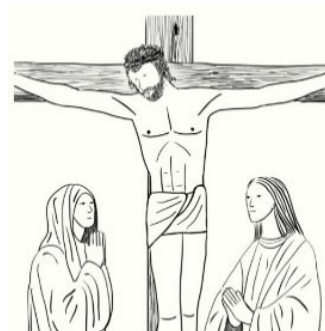

Easter Triduum

Our services for Holy Week and Easter will be celebrated across our two churches.

Holy Thursday, Mass of the Lord's Supper is celebrated at 7pm at **St Chad's** followed by Watching and Night Prayer.

The commemoration of the Passion of the Lord on Good Friday will be celebrated in both churches at 3pm. Fr Mark will lead one and Deacon Simon the other.

The Vigil of the Lord's Resurrection is celebrated on Holy Saturday night starting with the blessing of the Easter Fire outside church at 8pm at **St Bede's**. During this celebration we will welcome two adults who have asked to be baptised and two adults who will be confirmed and received into full communion with the Catholic Church. We keep them in our prayers.

Easter Morning Masses will be celebrated at 9.15am at St Chad's and at 9.30am and 11am at St Bede's.

We need some people to attend the 9.30am Mass as there may be too many people to accommodate at the 11am Mass if we don't divide those attending across both Masses.



Following the 9.15am Mass at St Chad's and the 11am Mass at St Bede's our Little Church teams have organised an **Easter Egg Hunt** around the grounds of our churches which all our children are invited to join but they must be accompanied by an adult.



Please keep in your prayers all the children who have now begun their preparation for their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion and their families and the four adults who will be baptised or received into full Communion with the Church at our Easter Vigil - Alan, Duncan, Josh and Kelly. Any adults in the parish who would like to be baptised, received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church or receive the Sacrament of Confirmation are very welcome to get in touch and we will be happy to help. Please talk to Fr Mark or to Sr Dorothy and we can look at how we can best support your decision.



Altar Servers. New servers are always welcome. Children in Year 4 or older are very welcome to learn how to serve at Mass. It's a great way to learn more about the Mass and help us to pray together. Please let Fr Mark know if you would like to join our team.
