Brindle St Joseph's ANNUAL ARROWSMITH WALK

Following some of the route of St Edmund Arrowsmith's last ride (About 5 miles)

31st August 2026 (Bank Holiday Monday)

The walk will start outside Church at 1.30pm

Arrowsmith House will be open until 3.30pm to view the room where St Edmund celebrated his final Mass before his arrest and Martyrdom.

After the walk, there will be **Mass in Church at 4.30pm** followed by light refreshments in the Parish Room. If you are unable to join in the walk you are very welcome to come to join in the celebration of Mass at 4.30pm.
